I supply letters from Alan Conger, Cliff Tholen and Chuck Seketa (thanks guys) January 2009 to the Army board of Corrections. Receive a reply from the Army Board of Corrections August 2009 - Denied my request - stated there was not enough information to substantiate my presence in a combat environment - I'm really upset over this - tempted to send all my records back to the army and tell them to shove it. Anyway, I have too much to be thankful for (i.e. 40 extra years of life) to dwell on this. Then on January 6, 2010, I receive a letter & ribbons, CIB, DD215 form (dated October 26th 2009) from the Department of the Army Review Boards Agency..."we are pleased to inform you that your records have been corrected in accordance with the findings of the Army Board for Correction of Military Records yada, yada, yda - anyway - I finally received my CIB - Means the world to me.
